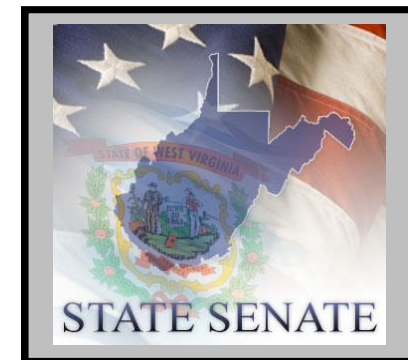

#### **ISSUE #1 - SB 12**

**Description:** Lengthened the time in which employers are required to pay outstanding wages to separated employees and reduced the financial liability on employers that do not meet the timeline.

**Voting Body:** 34-member Senate **The Vote:** Final Passage - RCS# 394 – SEQ. NO. 0032 - March 13, 2015- 7:28PM

**YEAS: 25 - NAYS: 9 - NOT VOTING: 0 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

#### **ISSUE #2 - SB 14**

**Description:** Creation of a second, unequal school system that would allow for-profit, out-of-state corporations pull taxpayer resources from current classrooms for a few select students and threaten teachers' rights.

**Voting Body:** 34-member Senate **The Vote:** Final Passage - RCS # 239 – SEQ. NO. 0025 - March 2, 2015- 6:51PM

#### **ISSUE #4 - SB 361**

**Description:** Legislation to repeal the state Prevailing Wage for public construction projects, opening the door for out-of-state contractors to bring outside and illegal workers into West Virginia at taxpayer expense.

**Voting Body:** 34-member Senate **The Vote:** Final Passage - RCS# 241 – SEQ. NO. 0001 March 03, 2015- 4:27PM

**YEAS: 23 - NAYS: 11 - NOT VOTING: 0 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

#### **ISSUE #5 - SB 361**

**Description:** Initially an attempt to eliminate prevailing wage altogether, the final version requires reworking, and likely scaling back, prevailing wage for public construction projects that are \$500,000 or more. For public construction projects under \$500,000, the prevailing wage has been abolished, opening the door for out-of-state contractors to bring outside and illegal workers into West Virginia at taxpayer expense. **Voting Body:** 10-member Joint Committee on Government & Finance **The Vote:** Motion by Senator Kessler to extend the deadline for calculating new wage rates to September 30.

NO. 0009 - February 27, 2015- 12:46PM

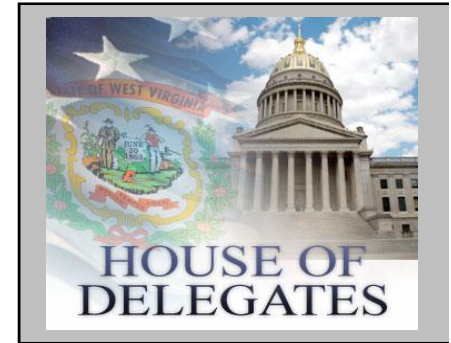

**Description:** Provides increased legal protection to employers that knowingly endanger their workers by failing to perform inspections, ignoring safety regulation violations or allowing other unsafe conditions -- in other words, rewards wilful corporate negligence. This bill makes dangerous work environments even more dangerous. **The Vote:** Final Passage – Senate Amended HB- RCS# 578 - March 14, 2015- 3:30PM

**YEAS: 63 - NAYS: 33 - NOT VOTING: 4 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

#### **ISSUE #2 - SB 12**

**Description:** Lengthened the time in which employers are required to pay outstanding wages to separated employees and reduced the financial liability on employers that do not meet the timeline.

**Voting Body:** 100-member House of Delegates **The Vote:** Final Passage - RCS# 506 - March 13, 2015- 12:29PM

**YEAS: 68 - NAYS: 31 - NOT VOTING: 1 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

#### **ISSUE #3- SB 14**

**Description:** Creation of a second, unequal school system that would pull taxpayer resources from current classrooms for a few select students and threaten teachers' rights. **Voting Body:** 25-member House Education Committee **The Vote:** Committee Passage

**YEAS: 15 - NAYS: 6 - NOT VOTING: 4 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

#### **ISSUE #4 - SB 357**

**Description:** A rollback of mine safety regulations to benefit big corporations

**Voting Body:** 100-member House of Delegates **The Vote:** Final Passage - RCS# 283 - March 03, 2015- 11:29AM

**YEAS: 72 - NAYS: 27 - NOT VOTING: 1 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

#### **ISSUE #5 - SB 357**

**Description:** A rollback of mine safety regulations to benefit big corporations.

**Voting Body:** 25-member House Judiciary Committee - **The Vote:** After countless hours of deliberation -- during which legislators who were deeply concerned about endangering miners unsuccessfully attempted several times to revive the safety requirements that the legislation rolls back -- the committee voted to report the Un-safety bill to the full House of Delegates.

**AYES: 16 - NAYS: 8 - NOT VOTING: 1 / AYE VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER - February 24, 2015**

#### **ISSUE #6 - SB 357**

**Description:** An unsuccessful attempt to amend the legislation that rolls back mine safety regulations by adding back to the state code language intended to protect miners from ventilation dangers related to smoke and fire in instances of moving equipment.

**Voting Body:** 25-member House Judiciary Committee **The Vote:** Adoption of the amendment

**AYES: 7 - NAYS: 17 - NOT VOTING: 1 / NAY VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER - February 24, 2015**

### **ISSUE #7 - SB 357**

**Description:** A rollback in state mine safety laws.

**Voting Body:** 100-member House of Delegates **The Vote:** An amendment to include an “economic impact study” in the bill. Even though the new Republican leadership touted “economic impact studies” for numerous issues at the beginning of the session, this amendment was voted down. It’s important to note that by the end of the session, the Republican leadership only called for one legislative issue to undergo an “economic impact study” -- so-called “Right to Work.”

### **ISSUE #8 - SB 361**

**YEAS: 62 - NAYS: 36 - NOT VOTING: 2 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

### **ISSUE #11- SB 529**

**Description:** Creates a new retirement tier, with much lower benefit levels, for all public employees hired after July 1, 2015. Also, veterans who served our country during times of conflict and are hired as state employees will now have to pay for their military service credit, a benefit that previously was at no cost to them. **Voting Body:** 100-member House **The Vote:** Final Passage - RCS# 643 - March 18, 2015- 3:28PM

**YEAS: 55 - NAYS: 38 - NOT VOTING: 7 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**

### **ISSUE #12 - SB 578**

**Description:** Relates to workers affected by all occupational diseases, including but not limited to black lung and asbestosis, by potentially eliminating an opportunity to receive additional benefits for a worsening or advancement of the disease.

**Voting Body:** 100-member House of Delegates **The Vote:** Final Passage - RCS# 427 - March 10, 2015- 3:20PM

**YEAS: 58 - NAYS: 39 - NOT VOTING: 2 – EXCUSED: 1 / YEA VOTE IS ANTI-WORKER**
